



AIA SF AWARDS FOR UNBUILT DESIGN



1 HONOR: **Hydro-Net**—a proposed citywide network of webs that collect, store and distribute power generated by fog and algae—was envisioned as the future of San Francisco by **IwamotoScott Architecture**.

2 MERIT: **IwamotoScott Architecture** modeled architectural elements on the form and features of underwater life for **REEF**, a proposed environment for New York City's MoMA/PS1 Urban Beach.

3 CITATION: **Kennerly Architecture & Planning** envisioned **1225 Dolores Street**—the last vacant lot on one of San Francisco's most desirable boulevards—with modernized bay windows to reference the styles of neighboring homes.

4 CITATION: Wanting to create a dignified and practical space for day laborers to gather and seek out employment, **Public Architecture** designed the **Day Labor Station**, a prefabricated structure equipped with a restroom and a small kitchen.

5 CITATION: For **Bodega Bauer Winery**, **Field Architecture** imagined a structure informed by the vineyard's soil, sunlight and rain—making the project, like the grapes on the surrounding vines, a true product of its environment.
